GENERAL GARBAGE PICKUP RULES, THESE RULES MUST BE FOLLOWED TO ENSURE PICKUP:

- Curbside pickup is for household garbage only.
- NO Construction debris, furniture, appliances, deer carcasses, pumpkins, concrete or Christmas trees will be picked up.
- NO Liquids -NO Steel -NO Concrete
- There is a limit of 2-35 gal. cans per week. (or the equivalent) If you have more than this you may be charged extra, or asked to switch over to a dumpster service.
- Garbage must be placed within 5 ft. of the roadside.
- Garbage and/or recycle must be placed at the curb by **5AM** the morning of pickup or the night before.
- Dumpsters and cans must be cleared of snow and/or debris to allow for pickup.

Each year we are required to notify our customers of the current Wisconsin Recycle laws. All Wisconsin residents are required to recycle items banned from Wisconsin Landfills.

Items that are banned that **WE DO NOT PICKUP** and need to be taken directly to the Juneau or Adams county landfills:

Tires	Steel	Yard Waste	Motor Oil	Paint
Electronics	Appliances	Oil and Oil absorbents	Batteries	

**ALL RECYCLE CAN BE PLACED TOGETHER AND LOOSE IN A CAN, BIN OR BOX THAT ONE PERSON CAN LIFT.
RECYCLE WILL NOT BE PICKED UP IF PUT LOOSE ON THE GROUND.
NO BAGS, TWINE OR WIRE**

What is recyclable?

All Plastic Bottles & Containers - Household bottles, jars and jugs
Please rinse all plastics Dairy Containers and lids
(no food residue) Produce, bakery and deli containers

Paper- Newspaper & Inserts
Shredded paper *(Can be placed in paper bags.)*
Phone books, books, and magazines
Food and Beverage boxes
Cardboard *(Flatten and put in box or can)*

Metal & Glass- Aluminum cans
Steel and Tin cans
Empty Aerosol Cans

What is not recyclable? *These items should be placed in the garbage.*

NO PLASTIC BAGS, FILM, MOTOR OIL OR ANTIFREEZE BOTTLES, STYROFOAM
NO PET FOOD BAGS, TISSUE PAPER OR GIFT WRAP
NO ALUMINUM PANS, FOIL
NO CERAMICS, CLAY PLOTS, LIGHT BULBS OR DISHES
NO CLOTHING, CARPET OR SHOES
